-Salvation Army Spring Fair, Harpenden 13th May

HBHC sang once again at the Salvation Army Spring Fair, which was held on Saturday 13th May. The event was held on Leyton Green in Harpenden (next to Waitrose.) It was supposed to be spring but it was a cold day accompanied by a biting wind! The chorus kicked off the event at 11:15 with what seemed an appropriate song - California Dreamin' - with its lyrics of cold days and dreams of warm beaches. Sweet Caroline got an inaugural rendition and is now firmly in the repertoire. We sang for 30 minutes in total, finishing with Amarillo which got the audience and stallholders alike dancing to the rhythm (probably helping to keep themselves warm!)
